The Racine Family YMCA is actively raising support to build a new facility in Mount Pleasant and will break ground in June or July. Recently, we approached the Mount Pleasant Village Board to request a financing option through the CDA. Though the trustees denied that request, they were supportive of the YMCA and its plan, and were amenable to financing through the village directly. We're appreciative of their willingness to help in this way and are carefully considering if this is the best option for financing the new YMCA construction. It has always been our intent to minimize financing and debt, and regardless of this one decision, we are continuing to work with companies and individuals throughout the community interested in donating to help build this new, second facility that will support the families and businesses on the community's western side.
